Kansas Mental Health Counselors Association (KMHCA) is an interdisciplinary division dedicated to maintaining and improving the quality of mental health counseling.

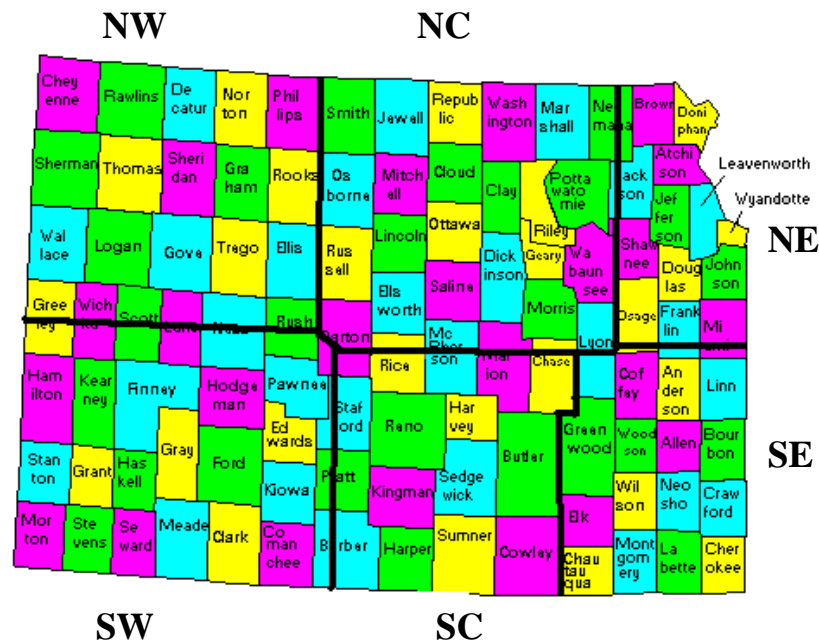
Kansas Association for Specialists in Group Work (KASGW) represents counselors who seek to assist a variety of individuals through the promotion and development of group methods.
